However, the burn wound is a dynamic living environment that will alter depending on both intrinsic factors (such as release of inflammatory mediators, bacterial proliferation) and extrinsic factors (such as dehydration, systemic hypotension, cooling).

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ABC of burns: Management of burn injuries of various depths

For serious burns, after appropriate first aid and wound assessment, your treatment may involve medications, wound dressings, therapy and surgery. The goals of treatment are to control pain, remove dead tissue, prevent infection, reduce scarring risk and regain function. People with severe burns may require treatment at specialized burn centers.

Management of Burns - World Health Organization

Studies have concluded that the management of burn pain can be inadequate, and such studies have advocated more aggressive treatments for pain resulting from burns. Lastly, some burns can be mentally traumatic and/or physically disfiguring and lead to psychological pain that must be addressed, as well.

Burns can be very painful and a number of different options may be used for pain management. These include simple analgesics (such as ibuprofen and acetaminophen) and opioids such as morphine. Benzodiazepines may be used in addition to analgesics to help with anxiety. [42]

Management of minor burns (isolated, <10% TBSA) Analgesia: may be required for assessment and initial dressings (see initial management). Consider sling and splinting for more extensive upper limb burns.

Superficial or first-degree burns (such as the sunburn shown) result in injury to the top layer of skin (epidermis) and cause the lower levels of the skin below the epidermis (dermis) to become red and

swollen. Treatment may include a cool towel, cortisone, topical aloe vera, nonsteroidal antiinflammatory drugs,...

Burns Management Guidelines Each year, at least 5000 Victorians are treated for burn injuries in emergency departments and hospitals across the state(1). Approximately 400 people will be transferred to Victoria's two designated Burn Services, and only 8% of these injuries are considered severe, that is >20% Total Body Surface Area burns (2).

For people with suspected superficial dermal burns and scalds, ensure that appropriate first aid has been given, and that the wound has been fully assessed. Ensure that the burn is suitable for management in primary care and does not require specialist referral.

Outpatient burn management can be taxing and, when poorly performed, can cause unnecessary suffering and compromise long-term results. In some situations, the best plan is to coordinate outpatient management with the burn unit's team of doctors, nurses, and therapists because their expertise may facilitate attaining optimal outpatient results.

Burn Management (continued) Healing phase • The depth of the burn and the surface involved

influence the duration of the healing phase. Without infection, superficial burns heal rapidly. • Apply split thickness skin grafts to full-thickness burns after wound excision or the appearance of healthy granulation tissue.

Management of the burns Prompt irrigation with running cool tap water for at least 20 minutes (but no more than one hour) provides appropriate cooling. Very cold water, ice and objects from a freezer to cool the area should be avoided as these cause vasoconstriction and may worsen tissue ischaemia and local oedema.
