The Basic Tenets of Swimming Pool Plumbing As water moves through pipes it creates friction, slowing it down, just like the air against your car as you drive down the road Excessive use of 90 degree elbows will hinder water movement and add a lot of friction Even 45 degree elbow slows the water down a little just like taking a turn in your car

Install your unit within close proximity of your swimming pool. The further away you install your unit from your swimming pool, the more heat you will lose from the plumbing and the lower the water flow rate will be. Install your unit on a sturdy base made of concrete, pavers, or any other material that can support its weight.

Equalizer Line Plumbing. Back in the day, it was common (not so much anymore) to plumb the skimmer with a built-in low water protection, known as an equalizer line. The equalizer line is a suction line installed below the skimmer, about 18" below the tile line.

The first step of proper pool plumbing is to determine the size and depth of the pool that you want built. Once you know this information you will need to calculate the number gallons your pool will hold. For a standard pool the following is the standard formula: Width X Length X Average Depth X 7.5 = Total Gallons.

Clean and glue your main drain pipe into 1 side of the valve and your skimmer to the other side of the valve. If there are two skimmers, a second 3-way valve is used, as shown in the pool plumbing diagram above. After the pump install a union, and then plumb to the inlet of your pool filter.

Plumbing and Controlling Solar Swimming Pool Heating Systems. The check valve prevents the water from running backwards through the filter (backwashing it) when the pool pump is shut off. It also prevents the

pump from losing its prime if it is above pool level. The vacuum breaker allows air to enter when solar shuts off.
