A typical reaction of silver nitrate is to suspend a copper rod in a silver nitrate solution and keep it undisturbed for a few hours. The silver nitrate reacts with copper to produce silver crystals along with a blue copper nitrate solution.  $2 \text{AgNO}_3 + \text{Cu} \rightarrow \text{Cu}(\text{NO}_3)_2 + 2 \text{Ag}$ . When Silver nitrate is heated, it decomposes.
